Orchardgrass

Highlights: High palatability and spring yield Seeding rate: New stand 20-25lbs/A, Interseeding 10-12lbs/A Seedling vigor: Moderate Drought tolerance: Low Flood tolerance: Low Fertility requirements: Moderate

Prairie Bromegrass

Highlights: Quality maintained throughout life cycle, reseeds itself, best for rotational grazing or dry hay Seeding rate: 25 to 30lbs/A Seedling vigor: Low to moderate Drought tolerance: Low to moderate Flood tolerance: Moderate Fertility requirements: Moderate to high Fertility requirements: Moderate to high

Festulolium

Highlights: Palatability and grazing tolerance, density of plant Seeding rate: New stand 20-25lbs/A, Interseeding 10-12lbs/A Seedling vigor: Moderate Drought tolerance: Low Flood tolerance: Moderate to high Fertility requirements: Moderate

Highlights: Treat as an annual, easy to dry down for hay Seeding rate: 10-15lbs/A Seedling vigor: Low Drought tolerance: Low Flood tolerance: Low Fertility requirements: Low
