Gaucho Bermudagrass	25	CT	8 to 12	A cold tolerant blend touted for it's early green up and weed suppression ability. Well drained soils.
Chilly Verde Bermudagrass	50	CT	8 to 12	Coated turf variety for lawns and landscapes.
Pensacola Bahiagrass	50	UT	12 to 15	An early maturing variety that comes in more quickly than TifQuick but doesn't last into the fall as well.
TifQuick Bahiagrass	40	UT	12 to 15	A newer variety that has slightly higher yields. Notable spring quickness.
